Course Description

This ensemble plays music of a high technical level and performs at numerous concerts, festivals, parades, athletic events and field shows. This class is the center of the Music Department at PGHS and is the premier performing group. The PGHS Band represents the school at public performances throughout the year. Active participation for a full year satisfies the Fine Arts Requirement. This course uses concert band and marching band literature to teach instrumental techniques, musicianship, music theory, and concepts of ensemble performance. Students are expected to participate in each day's rehearsal and practice their music outside of class as needed. This class may be repeated for credit.

Daily Rehearsal Expectations (5 points per day)

Teacher: Will provide music of high technical level, as well as presenting music from different cultural and historical backgrounds. The teacher will be prepared for class, and will have materials to play on a daily basis with extra curricular activities organized ahead of time.

Student: Students will ...

- 1) Participate in class by playing during warm-ups, tuning, and music rehearsal.
- 2) Remain focused and on task for the entire rehearsal period. Homework from another class is not permitted during rehearsal.
- 3) Come prepared to class with your instrument, instrument equipment, a pencil, and music.

4) BE POSITIVE! Respect the rights of others to work without disruption during rehearsals and performances.

Behavior Guidelines

Students will follow and be consistent with the behavioral guidelines for PGHS. In addition, rehearsals will start promptly after the tardy bell rings. This class will help develop a student's confidence in their ability to fulfill their unique potential in music, both on an individual basis and collectively as a group. Students must be in their seats with music and all class materials needed for class.

Challenge Procedures

1). You may only challenge the person sitting directly above you in your section, in your band. Before you see me, make sure you notify the person you want to challenge, that you want to challenge them!

2). Each person will pick a song of their choice and go together to see the director to schedule the challenge.

3). Although each person will choose the challenge material, the director will choose which sections are to be heard. These sections will be determined on the day of the challenge.

4). A person may only challenge once in a week. Results will be told as soon as possible.

5). No challenges will be allowed during the week of a concert.

6). Everyone is expected to treat everyone else in a positive manner and accept courteously the results of all challenges.

Evaluation Procedures

Attendance in class and performances Student's performance in class Group and/or individual testing with instructor (when applicable) Festival and Performances Participation and attitude in class Music readiness (memorizing and learning music)

Missed performance/concert equals loss of one semester grade (A to B, B to C, etc) without a valid excuse. Missed festival equals loss of 2 grades (A to C, B to D, etc.)

60% Performances/Playing Tests (concerts, festivals, parades, football/basketball games etc.)
*** Students must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA to participate in extra curricular field trips which are not mandated or do not have a direct affect on their grade in this class, i.e.
Disneyland trip, Hawaii trip, etc.
